BOWLING GREEN, KY – This fall, the Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Center ("SKyPAC") will welcome Contemporary Christian music superstars Crowder and Jason Crabb. Crowder, a chart-topping singer/songwriter/instrumentalist whose most recent album *Milk & Honey* debuted at #1 on *Billboard's* "Top Christian Albums" chart, will perform on Friday, September 23rd. ABOUT CROWDER

More than 3 million records sold and 3 GRAMMY nominations. Crowder's first solo album, *Neon Steeple*, debuted at Number Eight on the Billboard 200, was named iTunes 2014 Christian Album of the Year, garnered multiple radio hits, a GRAMMY nomination for "Come As You Are," a Grand Ole Opry debut, a Dove Award and multiple nods and numerous K-LOVE Fan Award Nominations. *American Prodigal*, the GRAMMY nominated follow-up album released in 2016, landed at Number One on the Christian & Gospel Album Chart, Number Three on the Digital Albums Chart, Number Five on the Top Albums Billboard Chart, and Number Twelve on the Top 200 Billboard Chart. "All My Hope" brought Crowder a Number One radio single. His third project, I Know a Ghost, hit Number One on the Billboard Top Christian Albums Chart and earned Crowder his third GRAMMY nomination for Best Contemporary Christian Album. Crowder's latest album, *Milk & Honey*, has already connected with the smash single "Good God Almighty" which hit Number One on Christian Radio and Number One on Billboard's Hot Christian Songs chart. Born out of the 2020 lockdown season, *Milk & Honey* is a celebration of the hope that God's promise remains true.

ABOUT JASON CRABB

Kentucky-born Jason Crabb has won a GRAMMY and 21 Dove Awards – being named the Gospel Music Association's Dove Awards Artist and Male Vocalist of the Year along with Song of the Year.

His electrifying stage presence, powerhouse vocals and magnetic personality have endeared him to millions across the world – through extensive personal appearances, media coverage, and social media including over 20 million views on YouTube. Jason has performed at many of the world's most prestigious stages such as Carnegie Hall, the Grand Ole Opry, the Brooklyn Tabernacle and Billy Graham's final crusade in NYC. He has also shared the stage with artists such as Gloria Gaynor, Kari Jobe, Vince Gill, Mary Mary's Erica Campbell, Donnie McClurkin, Wynonna, Brad Paisley, Blake Shelton, Michael W. Smith, Jamie Grace, Sandi Patty, the Oak Ridge Boys and more. He has appeared on NBC's "Celebrity Apprentice" and alongside Duck Dynasty's Willie Robertson. Crabb has been featured and covered by many media outlets as well, including *People Magazine*, *Fox News, Country Living, The Huffington Post, Billboard, USA Today, Entertainment Tonight*, and *Country Weekly*, among others, and was named one of Nashville's Most Beautiful People by *Nashville Lifestyles Magazine*. Crabb is also frequently seen on television hosting on TBN, appearing on awards shows and television specials for a variety of networks.

ABOUT ARTS OF SOUTHERN KENTUCKY

In 2020, with the assistance of the Warren County Fiscal Court and Judge Michael O. Buchanon, Orchestra Kentucky assumed management of the Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Center (SKyPAC). The new organization, which also includes BGOnStage and the Ramsey Theatre Company, is titled Arts of Southern Kentucky, and is led administratively and artistically by Jeffrey Reed.

The Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Center is a premier performing arts venue located in downtown Bowling Green, KY. The facility includes the Rita and Jim Scott Concert Hall, a 1,700-seat state-of-the-art auditorium; the Renshaw Education Center, which houses the Carol Wedge Studio Theater - a flexible 2,600 sq. ft. space for intimate productions and gatherings; several multi-functional rehearsal halls/classrooms; a children's art gallery and a main gallery.
